Leave No Trace® (LNT) is an educational program endorsed by the National Park Service, US Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. Many Girl Scout Councils have incorporated LNT into their Troop Camper and other outdoor courses, and LNT is now a part of the official Boy Scout program.

Who are the instructors?

Leave No Trace Masters, LNT Instructors, Agency personnel (USFS, BLM, etc.)

What will you learn?

You will learn to demonstrate and teach state of the art minimum impact techniques and outdoor ethics to scout troops, family, friends, and other community groups.

What to bring...

- Camping gear: sleeping bag, tent, clothing, and personal gear (in a backpack if possible) as if you were on a two-day backpacking trip.
- Please bring a place setting, cup, utensils and dunk bag.
- Remember the altitude—warm by day, cold by night. Dress in layers for mountain weather.

What do you receive for completing this course?

A national LNT Trainer's Certificate, LNT pin, patch a t-shirt, training manual, ideas, etc.

How much does it cost?

The fee for this course is \$45.00 for registered Girl Scouts and \$55.00 for non-members (includes GSUSA membership). The closing date is April 4, 2008.
